WEST VIRGINIA EMPLOYMENT SERVICES CAPTURE FEDERAL FUNDS

WASHINGTON, DC -- U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-WV) announced today that the U.S. Department of Labor's Employment and Training Administration is awarding Fiscal Year 1994 Employment Service Cost Reimbursable grants, totaling \$247,562, to West Virginia.

Over half of this funding will be used by West Virginia to provide a variety of employment placement services at no charge to job seekers and to employers seeking qualified individuals to fill job openings. Veterans receive priority treatment, and disabled individuals are entitled to special services.

The remainder of this funding, \$109,883, is for the Targeted Jobs Tax Credit (TJTC), which provides employers with a tax credit for hiring the chronically unemployed, disabled persons, and others who may have a particularly difficult time securing employment. "Key to the success of any comprehensive employment assistance program is the TJTC," said Rahall, "yet Congress refuses to authorize the TJTC for more than one year at a time. I will continue to fight to make TJTC a permanent program. We must help those with the greatest need for assistance."

Employment Service Cost Reimbursable Grants

The United States Department of Labor's Employment and Training Administration (ETA) has approved the Fiscal Year 1994 formula allocations for Employment Service (ES) Cost Reimbursable grant awards.

These grants are authorized under Section 7(c) of the Wagner-Peyser Act and funds are appropriated annually under the ES National activities budget. Awards will be made available to the States' employment security agencies through the Employment and Training Administration's regional system.
