CAMDEN-ON-GAULEY MEDICAL CENTER CAPTURES \$389,000 GRANT

WASHINGTON, DC -- U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-WV) announced today that the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services awarded \$389,130 to Camden-on-Gauley Medical Center.

The grant will help cover the operating expenses of this non-profit, community-based medical facility, which has been receiving such federal aid since it opened its doors to the Camden-on-Gauley community in 1979.

"Federal grants such as this are key to providing quality rural health care to West Virginians," said Rahall.
