

RAHALL ANNOUNCES \$43.8 MILLION FOR WV JOB & TRAINING PROGRAMS

WASHINGTON, DC -- U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-WV) announced today that West Virginia will receive nearly \$43.8 million from the U.S. Department of Labor for administration of various employment and training programs authorized in the Job Training Partnership Act and the Wagner-Peyser Act.

West Virginia will receive \$10,506,159 for employment and training assistance for dislocated workers. Dislocated workers are those who lose their jobs due to mass layoffs or plant closings, are long-term unemployed, or are eligible for or have exhausted unemployment insurance, and are unlikely to return to their previous occupation or industry.


For its adult training program, West Virginia will receive \$10,590,506; this money will be used to provide job training services to disadvantaged adults and others who face significant barriers to gaining employment. West Virginia's youth training program, which provides similar services to youths, will get \$6,986,253. Additionally, the state will get \$9,106,347 for the summer youth employment and training program.

\$6,601,249 will be awarded to West Virginia for public employment service programs, which involve a partnership between the U.S. Employment Service and the State employment security agency. The funds will be used to administer a labor exchange program responding to the needs of the West Virginia's employers and workers through a system of local employment service offices.

"The funding for these programs will help West Virginians who truly need assistance in securing a job to support themselves and their families," said Rahall. "This funding will help West Virginians help themselves."

Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA) Allotments and Wagner-Peyser Act Preliminary Planning Estimates

The U. S. Department of Labor's Employment and Training Administration (ETA) has announced 1994 JTPA allotments to the States and Insular Areas for administration of various employment and training programs for the public. These allotments are made annually under both the JTPA and the Wagner-Peyser Act.

JTPA funds are provided through block grants to the States and Insular Areas for employment and training programs that are administered by the States. Under Title II-A (the Adult Training Program), the States will receive approximately \$1 billion for job training services for disadvantaged adults and others who face significant employment barriers. Under Title II-C (the Youth Training Program), which provides similar services for youths, the States will receive about \$660 million. Under Title II-B (the Summer Youth Employment and Training Program), States will receive approximately \$900 million. Title III provides approximately \$1.1 billion for employment and training assistance for dislocated workers. Dislocated workers are those who lose their jobs due to mass layoffs or plant closings, are long-term unemployed, or are eligible for or have exhausted unemployment insurance, and are unlikely to return to their previous occupation or industry.

A total of approximately \$833 million will be allotted for public employment service programs. The public employment service involves a Federal-State partnership between the U. S. Employment Service and the State employment security agencies. Under the Wagner-Peyser Act, funds are allotted to each State to administer a labor exchange program responding to the needs of the State's employers and workers through a system of local employment service offices.
