THE CHECK REALLY IS IN THE MAIL Feds Send Half A Million Dollars To **Southern West Virginia Counties**

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The U.S. Department of the Interior is signing checks to the tune of over one-half million dollars to 11 southern West Virginia counties to compensate local governments which have Federal lands located within their jurisdictions, U.S. Rep. Nick J. Rahall (D-WV) announced today.

"When the Federal government purchases land, whether it is for a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers water project or a unit of the National Park System, the county is annually compensated for any loss of property tax revenue," Rahall said. "As such, people not only benefit from having a flood control project or park in the area but also from the payments made under this program."

The payments are being made under what is known as the Payments In Lieu of Taxes Program, or PILT. Rahall is a senior member of the House Committee on Natural Resources which has jurisdiction over the PILT program.

The funds, which total \$524,081, are being distributed as follows:
