CHARLESTON, W.Va. (AP) A U.S. House-Senate conference committee approved \$56.2 million in funding for several West Virginia projects, said Sen. Robert Byrd, D-W.Va.

The funding approved Wednesday includes:

\$5 million each for libraries at Marshall University and the College of West Virginia in Beckley.

\$4 million for a clinic at the School of Osteopathic Medicine in Lewisburg to serve residents of Greenbrier, Monroe, Nicholas, Pocahontas and Summers counties.

\$5 million for a science and technology training and education

center at Shepherd College.

\$9.9 million for a medical research facility at the Huntington Veterans Affairs Medical Center.

\$1.5 million for a health services demonstration project run by

the Clarksburg VA Medical Center and Ruby Memorial Hospital in Morgantown.

\$1.5 million for West Virginia University's Alternate Fuels Center and \$1 million for the EPA National Training Center at WVU.
