RAHALL AND FORMER ISRAELI
AMBASSADOR TO DISCUSS PEACE ISSUES

WASHINGTON, D.C.-- CONGRESSMAN NICK J. RAHALL, II (D-WV) ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT HE WILL BE IN HUNTINGTON ON MONDAY, OCTOBER 30, ACCOMPANIED BY AMBASSADOR SAMUEL W. LEWIS, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES INSTITUTE OF PEACE. AMBASSADOR LEWIS WAS THE AMBASSADOR TO ISRAEL UNDER PRESIDENTS CARTER AND REAGAN AND HAS BEEN A PROMINENT ACTOR IN ARAB-ISRAELI NEGOTIATIONS. THE CONGRESSMAN AND THE AMBASSADOR WILL GATHER IN HUNTINGTON TO DISCUSS THE ROLE OF THE INSTITUTE AS IT PERTAINS TO MARSHALL UNIVERSITY AND THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON. THEIR SCHEDULE IS AS FOLLOWS:

12:00 P.M.-- SPEECH BY AMBASSADOR LEWIS TO THE DOWNTOWN HUNTINGTON ROTARY AT THE RADISSON HOTEL. THE AMBASSADOR WILL SPEAK ON THE ROLE OF THE U.S. INSTITUTE OF PEACE.

4:15 P.M.-- RECEPTION AT PRESIDENT NITZCHKE'S HOME WITH MARSHALL UNIVERSITY FACULTY AND MEMBERS OF THE TRI-STATE PEACE FELLOWSHIP, ALONG WITH OTHER INTERESTED MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY. AMBASSADOR LEWIS WILL SPEAK BRIEFLY.
