\$200,000 AWARDED TO MARSHALL

WASHINGTON, D.C.-- Congressman Nick J. Rahall (D-WV) announced today that the Commerce Appropriations Bill for Fiscal Year 1990 will see that Marshall University will receive \$200,000 for their Institute for Advanced Flexible Manufacturing Systems.

"I AM VERY EXCITED TO SEE MARSHALL FINALLY GETTING THESE FUNDS SO THAT THEY CAN MOVE FORWARD WITH THEIR PLANS TO TRAIN CREATE NEW ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY IN SOUTHERN WEST VIRGINIA," SAID RAHALL.

THE CONFERENCE REPORT MUST BE APPROVED BY BOTH HOUSES OF CONGRESS FOR THE FUNDS TO BE DISTRIBUTED.

"I AM WORKING VERY HARD TO MAINTAIN THE LANGUAGE PROVIDED FOR IN THE APPROPRIATIONS BILL," SAID RAHALL.
