RAHALL ANNOUNCES FUNDING FROM URBAN MASS TRANSPORTATION

WASHINGTON, D.C.-- U.S. Rep Nick Rahall (D-WV) announced today that the Urban Mass Transportation Administration has awarded \$66,891 to health centers in the Fourth District for transportation equipment. The recipients are as follows:

o The Cabell-Wayne Association for the blind received \$8,000 for communication equipment.

o The Logan-Mingo Area Mental Health Center received \$13,437 for 15 passenger vans.

o The Prestera Center for Mental Health Services in Huntington received \$12,337 for 12 passenger vans.

o The Southern Highlands Community Mental Health Center received \$13,437 for 15 passenger vans.

o The Wyoming County Council on Aging received \$19,680 for 15 passenger converted vans.

"These funds will help these much deserving centers to obtain the equipment that they need," said Rahall. "It is my hope that, through whatever avenues we see fit, we will make sure that they receive their fair share."
