RAHALL PUMPS WATER FUNDING INTO WYOMING COUNTY

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-WV) announced today that the Appalachian Regional Commission has approved a \$242,560 grant to the Ravencliff McGraws Public Service District to extend water service to the Ravencliff McGraws and Saulsville area.

Rahall added that the waterline system will extend in three separate areas, and when completed, it will provide service to an additional 50 customers.

"I was recently in the Ravencliff McGraws and Saulsville area to help dedicate their new water system. These people need decent, clean water, and they deserve nothing less," said Rahall.

Rahall noted that in addition to the ARC funds, the Ravencliff-McGraws-Saulsville Public Service District will contribute \$60,640 for a total project cost of \$303,200.
