

## WAYNE COUNTY TO RECEIVE \$200,000 FROM ARC

WASHINGTON, D.C.— U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall announced today that the Appalachian Regional Commission has approved a \$200,000 grant to the Wayne County Commission for construction of approximately 12,000 linear feet of 6-inch diameter waterline along Carretts Creek Road. This project, which will insure safe and sufficient water supply, will serve 48 homes in that area.

"These ARC funds will help Wayne County insure that even more West Virginians receive the good, clean drinking water that they so richly deserve," said Rahall.
