## RAHALL: MINGO GETS MILLION FOR WATER PROJECT

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-WV) announced today that the Mingo County Commission will be able to undertake a million dollar water project that has been in the works for several months.

Rahall announced that the Appalachian Regional Commission has agreed to fund \$258,042 of the project while the state will be required to put up an additional \$491,958. The Justice Public Water District would then have to provide \$366,000 for a total project cost of \$1,116,000.

Rahall said that the funding would be made available for the purpose of providing a potable water system to the communities of Justice and Sprattsville and the residential/commercial areas between. The water system will include intake facilities, treatment, storage, distribution and metering.

WASHINGTON, D. C. -- The Appalachian Regional Commission announced today approval of a \$258,042 grant for the purpose of providing a potable water system to the communities of Justice and Sprattsville and the residential/commercial areas between. The water system will include intake facilities, treatment, storage, distribution and metering.

In addition to the ARC funds, the state will contribute \$491,958 and the Justice Public Water District will provide \$366,000 for a total project cost of \$1,116,000.
