**RAHALL CALLS FOR INCREASED BURDEN SHARING IN MIDDLE EAST**

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Joining Rep. Don Ritter (R-PA) in introducing a resolution in the House of Representatives U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall said the Congress should join the President in one voice by requesting U.S. allies to pay their fair share in the defense of the Persian Gulf.

In joining Ritter in introducing a resolution in the House of Representatives Rahall said, "We have defended Japan and West Germany for forty years to the tune of 10s of billions of dollars. We have been fair, to say the least. The United States' role as a democratic model for the world requires that we lead while others follow. But leadership doesn't mean we should have to continually bailout everyone but ourselves."

The resolution expresses the sense of the Congress that other countries benefiting from the deployment of United States military forces in Saudi Arabia and the Persian Gulf region should contribute to the cost of such deployment. This is in line with Rahall's long declared support of burden sharing among American allies, especially NATO, for mutual defense around the world.

"Peoples throughout the world will benefit by America's presence in the Middle East. It is simply fair for them to share this burden. The American taxpayer should not have to stand alone in this critical global crisis." Rahall said.
