RAHALL AND MINETA TO SURVEY WEST VIRGINIA HIGHWAYS

Washington, D.C. -- U.S. Reps. Nick Rahall (D-WV) and Norman Mineta (D-CA) will spend Saturday, September 22, 1990 for a tour of southern West Virginia and to review the road proposals of that area. Their schedule for the day is as follows:

Saturday, September 22, 1990

11:30 am -- Rahall and Mineta will arrive at the Big Sandy River Terminal to meet with Terminal officials to survey coal loading river terminal and discuss coal traffic on TOLSIA Highway.

12:30 pm -- Rahall and Mineta will meet at the Holiday Inn University Center for lunch with the TOLSIA Highway Upgrade Project proponents and the Point Pleasant to Huntington Highway proponents.

3:00 pm -- The Congressmen will meet at Mountview High School in Welch, West Virginia with Proponents of the Bluefield to Huntington Highway, the Shawnee Parkway, and the Coalfields Expressway.
