BRAMWELL PRINCIPAL RECEIVES AWARD OF EXCELLENCE

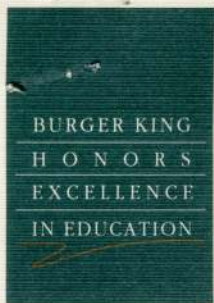


