

U.S. EDA AWARDS WY GRANT

WASHINGTON, DC -- U.S. REP. NICK RAHALL TODAY ANNOUNCED THAT THE U.S. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION HAS AWARDED THE REGION I PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL A GRANT FOR \$500,000.00 FOR THE CREATION OF A REVOLVING LOAN FUND TO FINANCE SMALL BUSINESS START UP AND EXISTING SMALL BUSINESS EXPANSION PROJECTS.

REP. RAHALL HAS WORKED WITH REGION I PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL AND NUMEROUS WEST VIRGINIA BANKS ON THIS PROJECT FOR TWO YEARS. LOCAL BANKS HAVE COMMITTED \$168,000.00 TO MATCH THE FEDERAL AWARD. BUSINESSMEN AND WOMEN WHO MAY NOT BE ABLE TO QUALIFY THROUGH TRADITIONAL LOAN PROGRAMS WOULD BE ABLE TO APPLY FOR LOANS FROM THIS FUND.
