

HUNTINGTON HOMELESS TO RECEIVE GRANT

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-WV) today announced that the city of Huntington will receive a \$51,000 Emergency Shelter Grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development to assist in the protection of the homeless community in that area.

The grant, which is provided for under the McKinney Act, will be used to improve the quality of homeless care, provide additional services, and help to defray the cost of operation.

"The homelessness problem is a problem for all of us," said Rahall. "Funding like this will make sure that Huntington's homeless are not forgotten."
