RAHALL CALLS SADDAM'S OFFER NOTHING NEW

WASHINGTON, D.C. — U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-WV) today reacted to Saddam Hussein's "peace plan" with skepticism calling it "nothing new."

"At least Saddam Hussein has admitted that he must leave Kuwait," said Rahall. "Other than that, he offers nothing new."

Rahall added, "Saddam Hussein is definitely feeling the pressure of allied bombing. He is slowly coming to the realization that his army is systematically being decimated, and that chances of winning this war are worse than none."
