WEST VIRGINIA HOSPITALS AWARDED ENERGY CONSERVATION GRANTS

BECKLEY, W.VA. -- U.S. REP. NICK RAHALL (D - W.Va.) TODAY APPLAUDED THE EFFORTS OF TWO HOSPITALS IN WEST VIRGINIA'S FOURTH DISTRICT FOR THEIR SUCCESSFUL COMPETITION IN OBTAINING GRANTS OF \$50,000.00 EACH FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY FOR ENERGY CONSERVATION. BECKLEY'S APPALACHIAN REGIONAL HOSPITAL AND CABELL HUNTINGTON HOSPITAL WERE AWARDED THE GRANTS TODAY.
