HUNTINGTON MUSEUM OF ART IS AWARDED NEA FUNDING

WASHINGTON, DC - The National Endowment for the Arts has awarded the Huntington Museum of Art a \$7,500 grant, according to U.S. Rep. Nick J. Rahall, II (D-WV).

Through their Museum Program, the NEA is able to fund various projects in areas such as special exhibitions, care of collections, professional development, museums purchase plan, arts and artifacts indemnity program, and museum resources. The funding received by the Huntington Museum of Art is earmarked for the conservation and treatment of their 19th-century art collection.
