## RAHALL ANNOUNCES \$81,967 FOR MARSHALL UNIVERSITY

WASHINGTON DC - U.S. Rep. Nick J. Rahall (D-WV) announced today that Marshall University of Huntington, West Virginia, has been awarded \$81,967 by the U.S. Department of Education.

Through Fiscal Year 1992, Marshall University will use this funding for a project to develop and maintain a family teacher training program focusing on infants, toddlers, and preschool children. This interdisciplinary program is one of the six National Education Reform goals adopted by the states and by Congress for attainment by the year 2000 to assure "school readiness" for all children.

"If we are to prepare our children for learning, through early intervention education, we most assuredly must prepare the teachers of those children," stated Rahall. "This grant will help Marshall's School of Education do just that."
