

RAHALL ANNOUNCES \$325,000

FOR JUVENILE JUSTICE & DELINQUENCY PREVENTION IN WEST VIRGINIA

WASHINGTON DC - U.S. Rep. Nick J. Rahall (D-WV) announced today that the West Virginia Criminal Justice & Highway Safety Office has been awarded \$325,000 by the U.S. Department of Justice.

Through Fiscal Year 1992, the Criminal Justice Office will use this money to develop innovative delinquency prevention programs and fund existing ones. Much of this funding will also be used to build and maintain separate detention facilities for juveniles, so that their contact with adult offenders will be minimized.

"West Virginia has been a leader in the effort to help young people, who have gotten into trouble, get back on the right track," stated Rahall. "This grant will help the state continue its successful program."
