MARSHALL UNIVERSITY TO RECEIVE FUNDING FOR MINORITY RESEARCH PROGRAM

WASHINGTON, DC. - U.S. Rep. Nick J. Rahall (D-WV), announces that Federal funding totaling \$15,000 has been granted to Marshall University for the Minority High School Student Research Apprentice Program (MHSRAP) for FY 1992.

Awarded by the National Center for Research Resources, this funding enables minority high school students the chance to participate as apprentices, conducting biomedical research for Marshall's School of Medicine.

"This program provides benefits for both the students and the university," Rahall explains. "Through the research these students expand upon their education, while providing valuable information to the school."
