

MARSHALL RACKS UP THREE RESEARCH GRANTS FOR SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

LOGAN, WV -- U.S. Rep. Nick Rahall (D-WV) today announced the Marshall University School of Medicine was furnished with three research grants from the Department of Health and Human Services, totaling \$303,222.

The Department of Biochemistry will receive \$126,496 for there work with progestin stimulation of c-myc and breast cancer growth; the Family and Community Health Department secured \$74,070 for their predoctoral training in family medicine; and \$102,656 was allotted for research on infant temperament in rural appalachia.

"When the federal government supports Marshall University's School of Medicine, the entire country wins," said Rahall. "Because the important research they perform benefits not only the people of rural America but the nation as a whole."
