As you may know, the Energy Emergency Act was recently passed by the Congress and did contain a price rollback provision. Last week this legislation was vetoed by the President, and the veto was sustained in the Senate. However, I am still hopeful that we can get an energy bill passed.

With reference to your further inquiry, I am pleased to advise that legislation was recently enacted providing for the continuation of the Public Employment Program for another three years.
