MEMORANDUM TO ALL THE MEMBERS OF THE TRUMAN COMMITTEE

Mr. Donald Nelson has suggested that he would like to discuss with the members of the Committee some of the issues underlying the proposed annual report at a private luncheon or dinner. He has suggested luncheon on Monday, February 21. I told him that because the Senate would be in session, it would probably be difficult to have a luncheon, but possibly it could be arranged in the Capitol in Room 68.

Mr. Nelson has expressed general agreement with the Committee's proposed report, and I think his purpose is to indicate that he wants to go along with it, but wants to have support in case some of the members of his own organization and some of the war agencies attack him.
