Honorable Sir:

If you think an appliance which will enable a pilot of a battle ship, underseas boat, or any other water craft to turn left or right in a very short space to avoid an attack by an enemy submarine or raider, ask to see my correspondence under date of June 13th, 1942 together with picture to Secretary of the Navy, Office of Inventions, Navy Department, E.N. 1-9 (H.L.P.-L.B.).

The more speed the ship, the faster it will turn right or left. This can be demonstrated with a row boat that has a rudder and the manipulation of two oars.
