MEMORANDUM TO THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE:

As you were notified yesterday, Mr. Charles E. Wilson of the War Production Board will discuss some of the questions raised by the report on problems of conversion from war production to peace-time production at a private dinner on Tuesday, November 9.

A request has been made to the War and Navy Departments that they give the Committee, informally, their views on these problems in private hearings to be held on Wednesday or Thursday, November 10 or 11, if convenient. You will be notified of the exact times and Room number as soon as that can be determined.

The above private hearings would form a basis which would enable the Committee to set public hearings commencing Tuesday, November 16, at which businessmen could state the problems which face them, and their suggestions as to how they should be handled.
