Your message of November eighth suggesting the appointment of Mr. Nestor Lamond, unfortunately deals with a subject which goes beyond the scope of the Committee's activities. Committees of the United States Senate, and this Committee in particular, do not make a practice of taking a position on personnel matters. This Committee has had a very specific rule against such procedure and has always been most scrupulous in refusing to deal with matters which are strictly a question of personnel.

The Committee shares your interest in achieving the best possible production at the Gramps Shipyard, and I am sure that this will be accomplished as a result of the vigorous efforts of all concerned.
