The writer recently interviewed a Mr. Bob Taylor of the Scripps-Howard Newspaper Bureau, who advised that he had investigated a report that prisoners of war held at Mt. Holly Springs in Cumberland County near Carlisle, Pennsylvania, had been taken to Deer Lodge, which is just outside of Mt. Holly Springs, for purposes of drinking beer, and were transported in Army trucks under guard.

Mr. Taylor stated that at the time of his investigation, this practice had been discontinued and officials disclaimed any knowledge of it; however, the details are known to the Sheriff's Office of Cumberland County.
