Due Here for
Ship Inquiry

The Senate war activities investigating committee headed by Senator Harry S. Truman (D.) Mo., is due here today. It is on the Pacific Coast to investigate shipping, having concerned itself within the last few days at Seattle with the troubles of Liberty ships.
