WALLGREN HERE FOR SHIP PROBE

Sen. Mon C. Wallgren, instigator of the investigation into Liberty ship failures now being conducted nationally by the Truman committee, of which he is a member, arrived in Seattle yesterday.

Senator Wallgren, as advance man for the committee, will spend the week in preparation for opening of public hearings in the Federal Office Building here on March 27.

Expected here prior to opening of the inquiry are Sens. Harry S. Truman, Mo., and Harry Kilgore, W. Va.; the committee's chief counsel, Hugh Fulton, and two investigators.

The Seattle hearing, to which will be summoned witnesses from Portland, Ore., is scheduled to last three days and will be followed by a similar inquiry in San Francisco.
